New IATF 16949 Documented Policies (3) & Documented Processes (21)

IATF has changed in a major way as it responds to the ambiguity of ISO 9001:2015. The requirements for policies have been expanded and the 7 required "documented procedures" has been replaced with 21 "documented processes" with the 2016 release. There are no documented procedure or documented processes required in ISO 9001:2015, which is a major change.
